

Important Information

Your booking has been placed in our reservation system and will remain as Provisional until the despoit has been received. Deposit cheques can be mailed to the Booking Secretary using the address sent to you in your confirmation email.

All bookings remain provisional until the deposit has been received and are open to other groups.

What to Bring

The kitchen has many appliances and equipment for renters. However, we ask that you bring your own cooking pans and utensils. Campers will need their own cutlery, plates and cups.

Our bunkhouse has basic bunks and campers will need their sleeping bags and roll mats for comfort. The bunkhouse is heated.

If you are using the meeting cabin for formal meetings, please bring any whiteboard markers, chalk and flip-chart paper you require.

Check-in

You will be met at the camp on your arrival and as part of the check-in process, we'll do a quick walkthrough and show you where everything is. As part of this process, we will hand over the keys and take any remaining payment for the camp. Please make sure to bring the payment with you. Your costs will be indicated in your reservation email.

Departure

On your departure date, we will arrange a convenient time to meet with you and walkthrough the camp to ensure it has been left clean and tidy. We will also require the keys. Departure times can be flexible and we will work with you if you need to depart early or late for travel purposes.



Camp Rules

Camp Caillet is rural but we do have neighbours! Please make sure that quiet time is no later than 11pm, and noise is minimal until 7am.

Please use the wood provided in the woodsheds and be responsible with burning - no large fires or burning of plastics.

Please treat the facilities with care, we hope that campers will refrain from climbing on the buildings and damaging the facilities.

Leave the camp as you find it - please remove all litter (use the blue dumpster), pick up any food scraps and make sure camping areas are cleared before you depart.

Please make sure campfires are lit using the fire rings around the camp and are extinguished after use - no fires are to be left unattended.

Please do not drive or park vehicles on the grass in wet weather.

Please store food in secure containers or in the kitchen - we have had bears in the camp in the past.
