Drop off only in the parking lot for participants.

Designated program leader parking.

Marked separate areas for groups to meet and maintain PHO orders for size limits/distance

Hot water available for sanitation

Sanitation stations

Safety Precautions Other:

AED located on wall in the Male Washroom Water on site is potable.

Restricted and hazard areas marked.

Frequent maintenance to resolve issues associated with a rural camp

Emergency contact sheet posted on kitchen

Potable hot water onsite.

Camp Caillet is located in a 911 service area.

Groups using the facility are responsible for their own first aid kits.

Emergency meeting (muster) point to be determined upon commencement of activity. Main field flag pole recommended.


